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The Ramakrishna Mission Boys' Home Industrial Training Centre is a branch of Ramakrishna Mission Boys' Home, Rahara which is one of the branch centre of Ramakrishna Math & Ramakrishna Mission, Belur, Howrah.

The Boys' Home started to serve its activities with 37 orphanage boys', on 16th August, 1944, under the shadow of founder Secretary Monk Late Swami Punyanandaji Maharaj.

Beside general stream education, Ashrama has started an Industrial Training Centre (Formerly named Junior Technical School) since 1957 for the benefit of Ashrama boys' who are unable to continue their studies in the general stream.

The Ramakrishna Mission Boys' Home Industrial Training Centre is situated at Rahara (Khardaha) about 19 Km(30 minute in Train) from Sealdah (Kolkata) Station.

CRAFTSMAN TRAINING SCHEME (ITI COURSES)

D.G. & T, Ministry of Labour, Government of India.

The craftsman Training Scheme (CTS) was introduced by the Government of India.

- To provide industry with skilled workers in different trades to raise the quantity and quality of production.
- To provide young and energetic men with job-oriented education to reduce unemployment.
- To develop a technical and industrial attitude in the minds of the younger generation.

SCOPE OF THE COURSE :

On completion of training the candidate is eligible to appear at the All India Trade Test (A.I.T.T) (Semester System) for craftsman conducted by N.C.V.T (National Council for Vocational Training) and will receive the National Trade Certificate (N.T.C) after passing the examination.

The technical education- imparted through emphasis on practical training along with relevant theory – provides the skill and certification required for earning livelihood through –

- i) Apprenticeship
- ii) Job as skilled technician in industry (Including Central and State Government Organization.
- iii) Self- Employment.

Students of Electrician & Turner Courses may also pursue higher studies in Diploma Engineering through 'VOCLET' and advanced courses in institutes like ATI, Dasnagar and CTTC, Bonhooghly, Kolkata after successful completion of the Course of Training.

TRADES offered for admission in the session commencing on September, 2020.

One unit of each of the following trades under the Craftsmen Training Scheme are being offered in this session.

Admission Procedure : Selection will be based on a merit-list prepared as per the marks secured in class X and interview.

How to Apply : Duly filled application form provided online link, from the Institute website notice has to be submitted online only within schedule date. Applications sent by post will not be accepted.

- Candidate must have own email id, mobile number, Aadhaar card. This will be used during the payment as well as form fill-up process and all the future communications between institute and candidate.
- Go to the online payment gateway as mentioned in this page and submit the Application Form Fee of Rs.200/- only.
- After successful payment keep the payment ID. (example : MOJOXXX....)

- **Document to be submitted along with Application Form:** After payment, keep ready the payment ID (example : MOJOXXX...., try to copy paste the payment id in Google form, it must be correct, other wise your form is cancelled) number and scan file of necessary documents- pass port photograph, Aadhaar card, class X Admit card, Marksheet and Certificate, Self & Guardian signature, SC/ST/PH category certificate if any, before starting Form fill-up. Maximum upload file size is between 100kb to 500kb.
 - Click on Admission Form Link given below and fill-up, upload the documents and submit online it within the specified last date.
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- Applicant can submit **only one** application form for admission.
 - Applicant can give choice in order of preference for **three trades** in one application form.
 - Documents for submission required along with Admission Form can be self-attested & uploaded. Originals need be shown only during viva-voce/mock test.
 - **Fresh Madhyamik students who have not received their result should wait till their result before filling up form. Fifteen days' time after publication of Class X Board result will be given for form fill-up. Please see website for updates.**

Attested copies of age proof (Admit Card), Madhyamik examination Mark sheet, (medical fitness certificate from MBBS Doctor, school/college leaving certificate last studied (original) after final selection).

Reservation : As per norms there is reservation for SC, ST, OBC and Physically Handicapped Candidates. Candidates wishing to avail reservation should produce attested copies of the relevant documents.

Physical Standards and mental requirements : The Candidate should possess sound mental and physical health, should be free from any chronic disease/ disability and have no cardio vascular problems or surgical deformities.

Caution Money : Caution Money is refundable after leaving the course. However it is to be claimed within three years of leaving failing which it will be forfeited. Caution money may be increased during the course period if there is excessive damage or loss.

Attendance : Minimum compulsory attendance is 80% .

Uniform : Two sets of Navy Blue Shirt, Steel coloured Full Pant, Blue/Grey/White/Brown coloured sweater for winter.

Hostel Facilities: No hostel facility is available.

Concessions: Railway Concession is available in the local trains for students commuting daily from their homes to the Institute.

Scholarships: 20 Students who are meritorious, sincere and obedient but financially weak are provided with scholarships every year.

Library : Our Library has a rich source of study materials including syllabus books brought out by NIMI, Chennai for issue and reference

Fees : The fee will be charged as per the existing government norms. Additionally, management charges fee towards uniform, their amenities, etc. The Government has fixed following fees and it is liable to change as per the directions of the government.

Employment:

a)Electrician :-

There is vast demand for ITI Electricians. The Electrician Craftsman can work in Govt. sector and Private Industries as a lineman, wireman, maintenance electrician, electrical supervisor, electrical contractor, Service technician, expert re-winder of motors, lab. Technician electrical maintenance Foreman etc or self-employment.

b) Turner :-

* Manufacture of small quantities of custom-made components that may be part of a larger machine tools or piece of custom-built plant or equipment.

*Manufacture of large quantities of identical components for inclusion of mass-produced consumer items such as motor cars, trucks, plant or equipment. *Modification or manufacture of replacement parts for existing machine tools plant or equipments these have become worn or damaged while in service.

c) Welder :-

*Structural Fabrication like bridges, Roof structures, Building & Construction.

*Automobile and allied industries, ship building and repair.

*Site construction activities for power stations, process industries and mining.

* Service industries (BHEL, BEK, NTPC etc) and private industries in India & abroad, in petrochemical industries like ONGC, IOCL, HPCL etc.

* Self employment by taking up fabrication works.

d)Fitter: -

It is a one of a mechanical **trade**. Its course duration is two years and you can learn how to fix pumps, valves, gears, and other mechanical fitting and joints and fixings the leakage.
